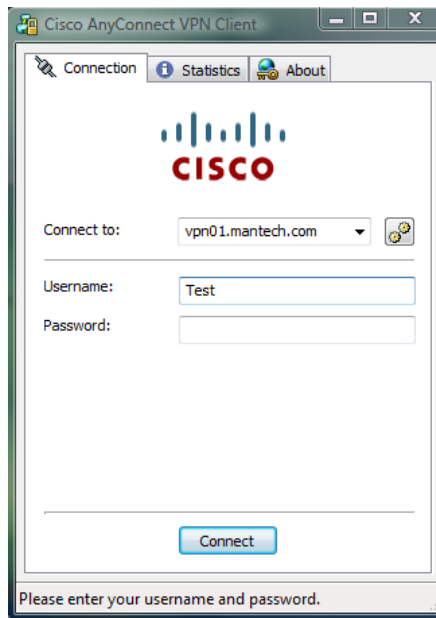




## Cisco AnyConnect VPN User Guide

---

The following document describes how to establish a secure, private, and encrypted connection to the ManTech network using the Cisco AnyConnect Client.



**Current VPN Users: You should uninstall previous versions of the Cisco IPsec VPN Client via Add/Remove Programs before proceeding. A guide to uninstall the previous VPN client is located at <https://unite.mantech.com> in the Customer Support Center and then under VPN Access.**

The AnyConnect client automatically attempts to install itself until successful or prompts the user for a manual installation. The client first uses Active X, if this fails or if the user waits 30 seconds AnyConnect will automatically attempt to install using Java, if this fails the user will be given a manual installation .exe that can be run to install the client

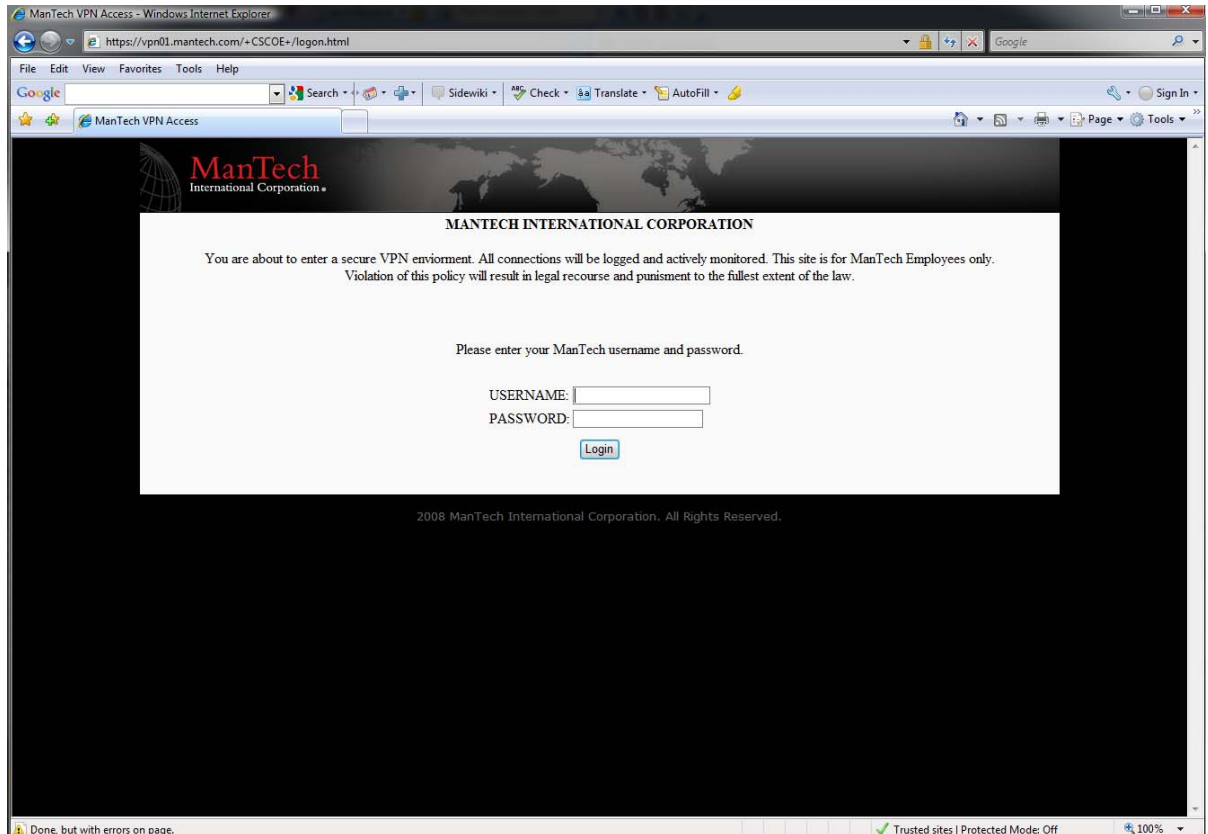

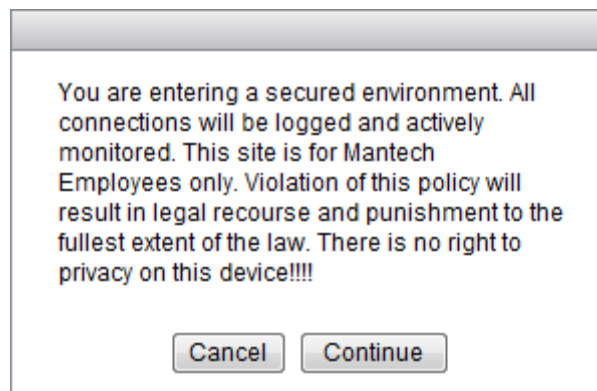

### Installation

1. Navigate to <https://vpn.mantech.com> and enter your ManTech username and password.



2. Select Continue.

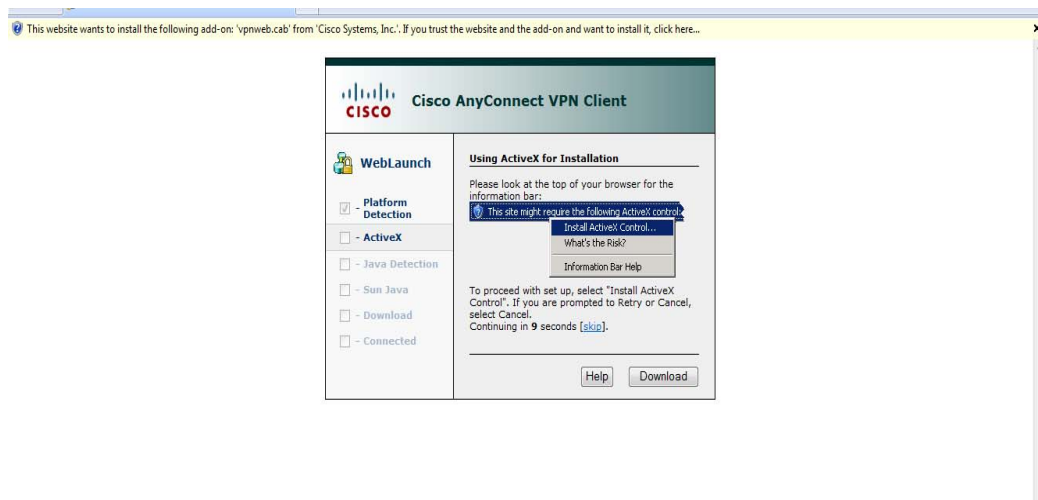

### Active X Installation

1. AnyConnect will first attempt to install using Active X.



2. If you right click and select allow on the security pop up and then select install the AnyConnect client can automatically install and connect.



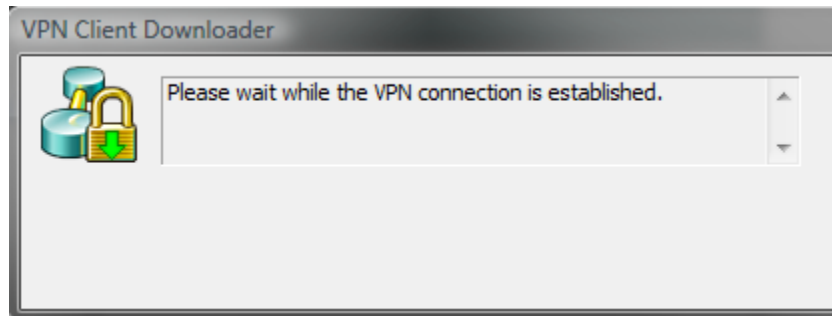

3. If active X installation was successful you will see a screen indicating Connection Established.



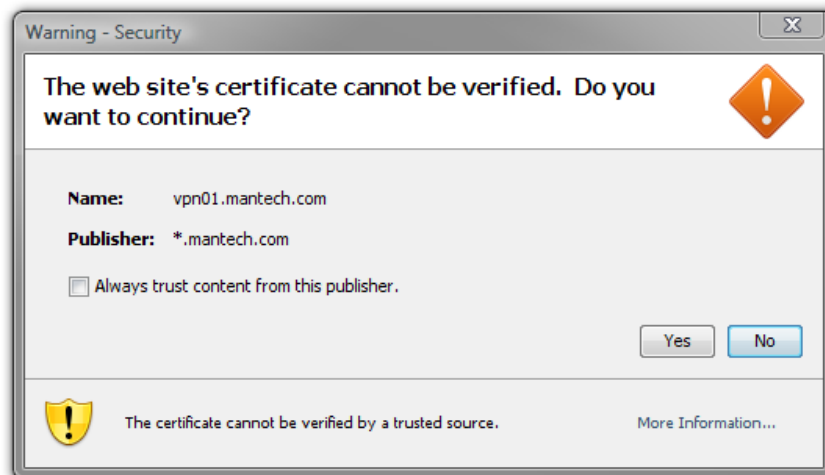
If you wait 30 seconds or do not wish to use active X the client will automatically move to the Java installation

### Java Installation

1. If Active X is not permitted or the user waited 30 seconds AnyConnect will automatically attempt to install using Java.



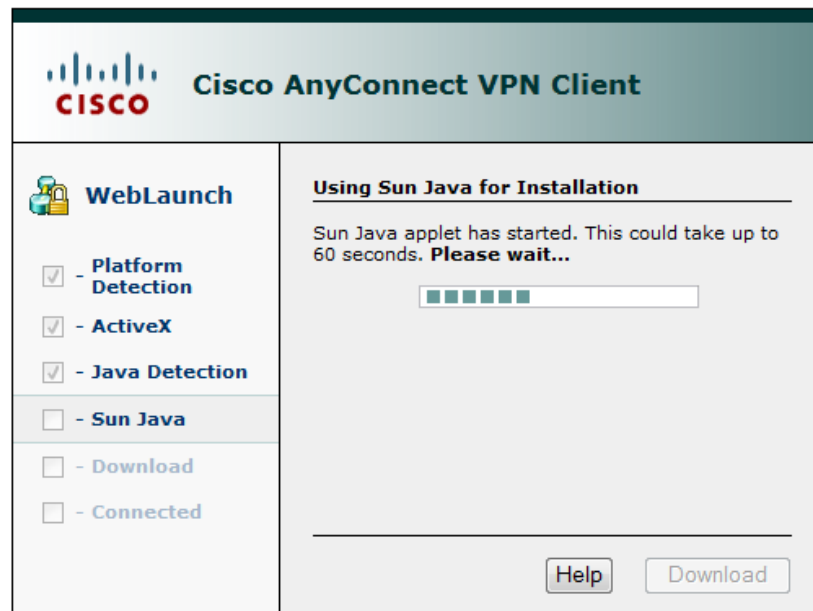
2. Select Yes if you are prompted to accept the website certificate and the java installation will begin.

3. If the AnyConnect Java installation is successful you will see a Connection Established message.

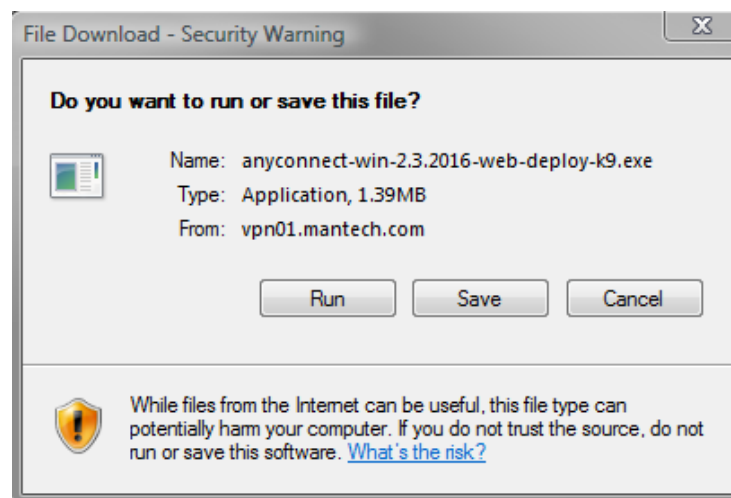

### Manual Installation

1. If Active X and Java installations both failed a manual installation can be followed by clicking the Install link that AnyConnect Provides.



2. After Clicking the Link select Save.

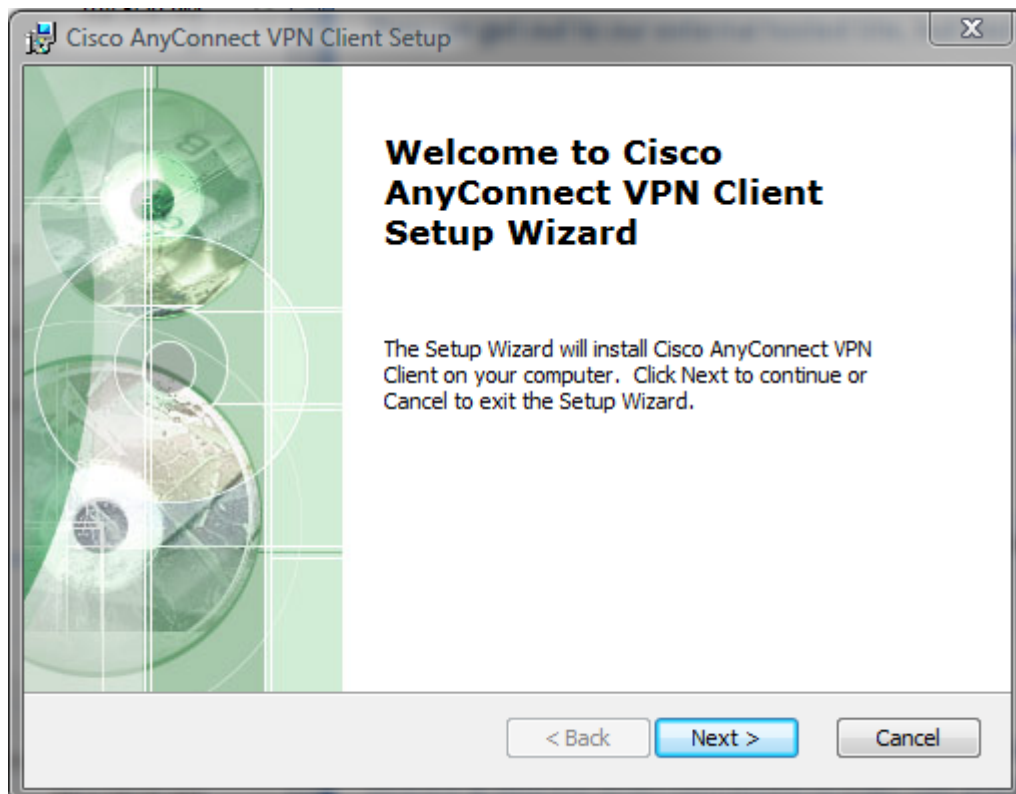

4. Select Next.





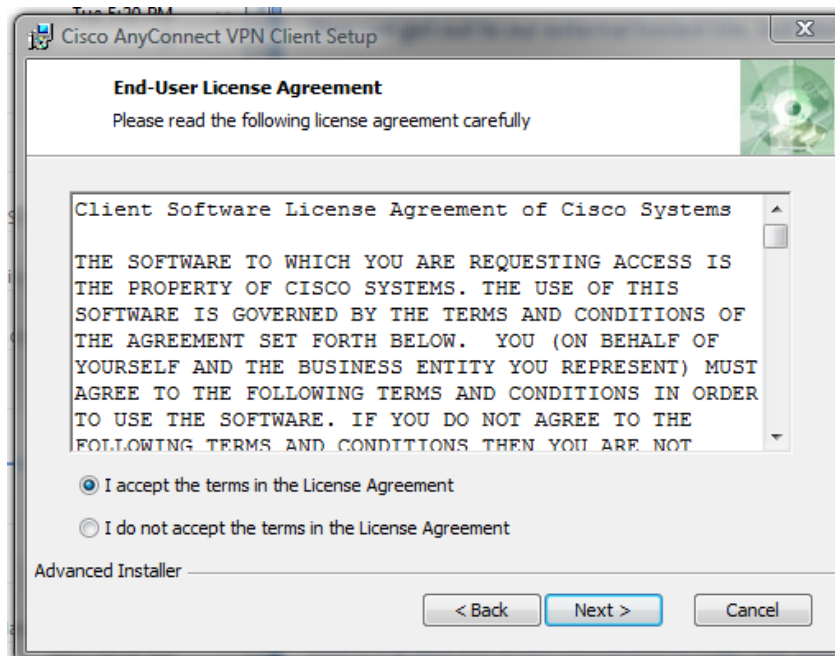

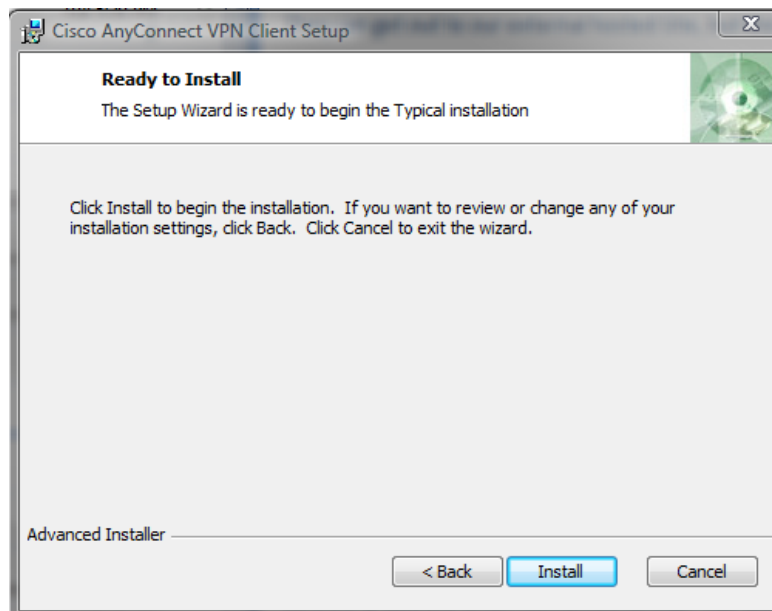

6. Select Install.



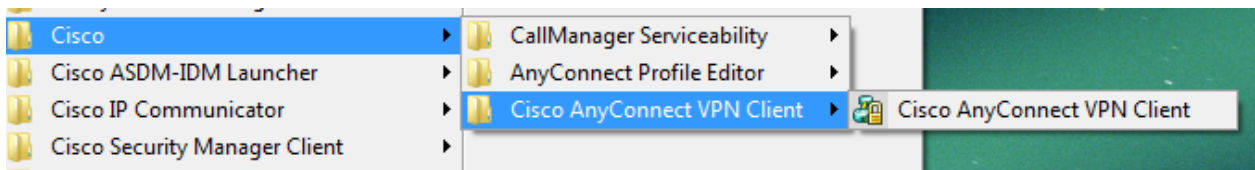

7. After Installation is completed select Finish.
8. To navigate to the AnyConnect client go to Start, Programs, Cisco, Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client, and click Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client.

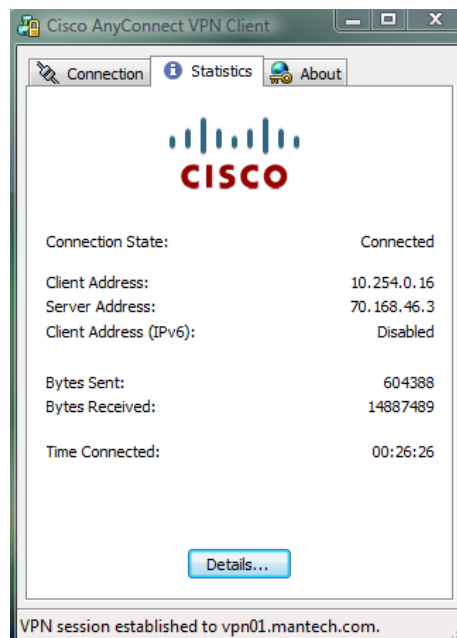


### Verify Connection

The AnyConnect VPN client can be seen in the bottom left Taskbar, the icon is two Green computer screens with a Lock.



If you doubleclick the icon you will be presented with the following.



The Connection state will say Connected.

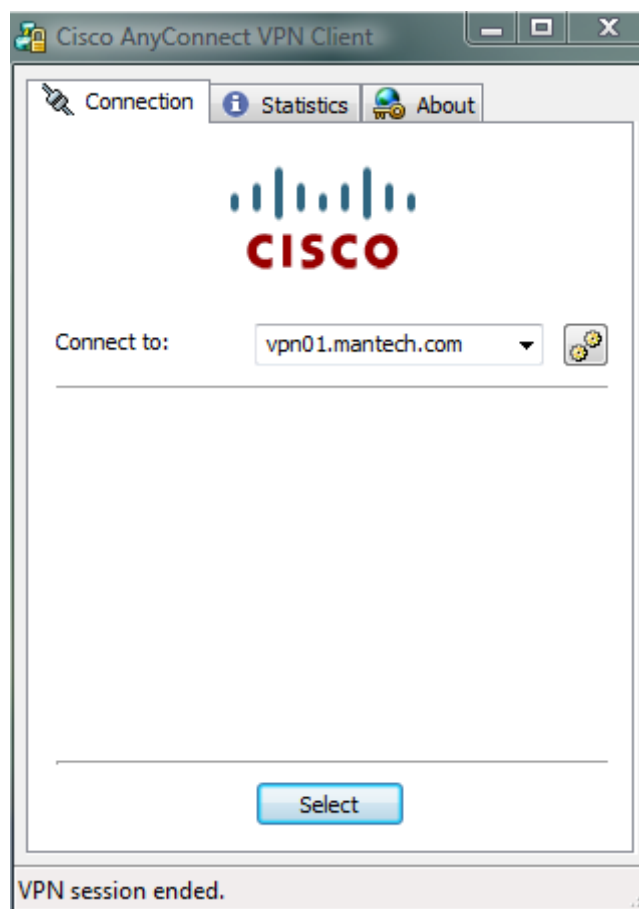

To disconnect from the VPN double click the AnyConnect VPN taskbar icon.

You can now close the AnyConnect Client by clicking the X in the top right corner.

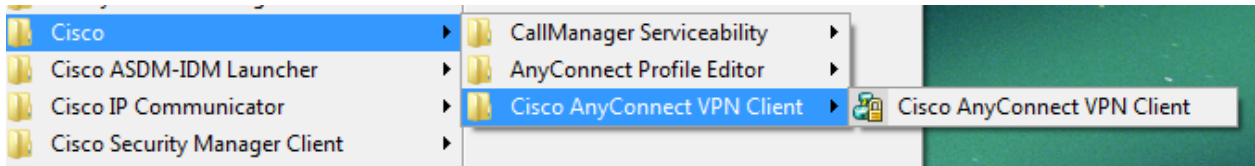

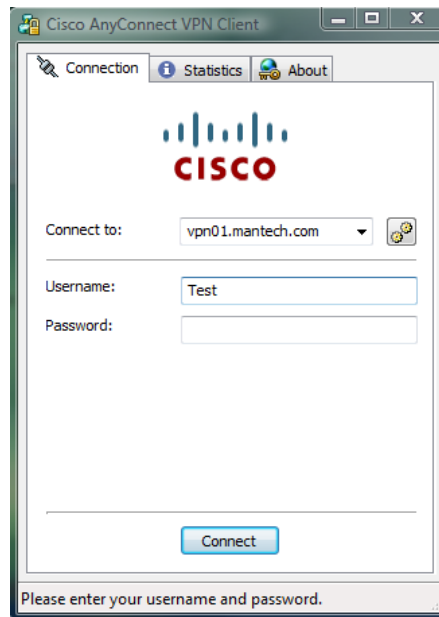

If you would like to reconnect navigate to the AnyConnect client go to Start, Programs, Cisco, Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client, and click Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client.



Or create a AnyConnect Shortcut on your Desktop

Note: To create a shortcut right click the Cisco AnyConnect Client from the start menu and select create shortcut. You can then drag and drop this shortcut onto your desktop. After double clicking the AnyConnect Client Enter your username and password and press connect.



Press Accept for the ManTech policy and the window will minimize. The green icon with a Lock will show that you are now connected.
