Lieutenant Colonel Robert H. Topper Jr. (Bob) is currently the Battalion Commander of the 2nd NATO Signal Battalion (2NSB) under the NATO Communication and Information System Group (NCISG). He is responsible for the training, maintenance, operational planning and tactical command and control of 11 deployable CIS assets in support of NATO operations and exercise. 2NSB is composed of 467 Army, Air Force, and Navy service members and civilians from nine Nations and geographically dispersed in three European counties.



Bob Topper was born in 1977 in Hanover, Pennsylvania. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education from Clarion University of Pennsylvania in Clarion, Pennsylvania in 2001. Upon graduation, he enlisted in the United States Army and served in the Transportation Corps. He commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the U.S. Army through the Officer Candidate School at Fort Benning, Georgia in September 2004. He is currently a year group 2002 US Army Signal Corps Officer. He is currently working on his MBA from Webster University.

He served in various leadership positions with experience in both tactical and strategic communication operations. He has deployed for 34 months to Kuwait, Iraq and Afghanistan in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM, OPERATION NEW DAWN, AND OPERATION FREEDOM SENTINAL.
