

3. The MCASB, NSA considers this an editorial edition to the STANAG; previous ratifying references and implementation details are deemed to be valid.

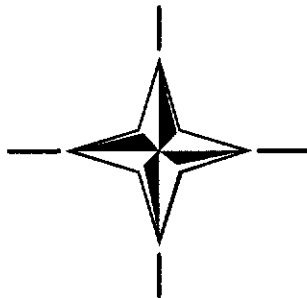

EXPLANATORY NOTES

AGREEMENT

1. This NATO Standardization Agreement (STANAG) is promulgated by the Director NATO Standardization Agency under the authority vested in him by the NATO Standardization Organisation Charter.
2. No departure may be made from the agreement without informing the tasking authority in the form of a reservation. Nations may propose changes at any time to the tasking authority where they will be processed in the same manner as the original agreement.
3. Ratifying nations have agreed that national orders, manuals and instructions implementing this STANAG will include a reference to the STANAG number for purposes of identification.

AIM

1. The aim of this agreement is to register national acceptance of AAP-46 and to provide definitions of terms in the specialist terminology used in the field of NATO aircraft armament systems.

AGREEMENT

2. Participating nations agree to use AAP-46 as the aircraft armament system terminology for NATO forces.

3. Changes to AAP-46 will be incorporated in the publication and will be accepted as part of it provided they have been agreed in accordance with the procedures laid down in Part I of AAP-6.

CONTENTS

4. Terms and definitions already contained in the Concise Oxford Dictionary, le Petit Robert and AAP-6 are not normally repeated in the glossary except where it is necessary to establish a definition to fit the specialist field of aircraft armament systems.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT

5. This STANAG and AAP-46 are implemented when the AP has been received by the authorities and units concerned.
