AGREEMENT

1. The aim of this agreement is to register national acceptance of AJP-3.3.1(B).

AGREEMENT

- 2. Participating nations agree to use AJP-3.3.1(B).
- 3. Changes to AJP-3.3.1(B) will be incorporated into the publication and will be accepted as part of it provided they have been formally offered by the MCJSB, NSA to national authorities concerned and have been agreed by them.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AGREEMENT

4. This STANAG and AJP-3.3.1(B) are considered ready to be implemented when they have been received by authorities and units concerned and will be implemented on the NATO Effective Date (NED) promulgated by the MCJSB, NSA.
